## Wheelchair users and people with mobility restrictions

- Passenger drop-off point immediately at the side of the building.
- Automatic doors.
- Lift access to all floors.
- Designated areas for wheelchair users and people with mobility restrictions
  - Theatre – up to 20 wheelchairs





## Blind and visually impaired people

- Listen Tek, a listening aid is available for loan should the production offer audio description for the Blind and visually impaired patrons.
- Guide dogs are welcome



## Deaf and hard-of-hearing people

- Closed Captions screens are located both in the Theatre Stalls and Circle. They are obstruction free and are visible to everyone in the theatre.
- Platform can be placed at the designated locations near the stage to obtain the optimum view of the show and the interpreter.

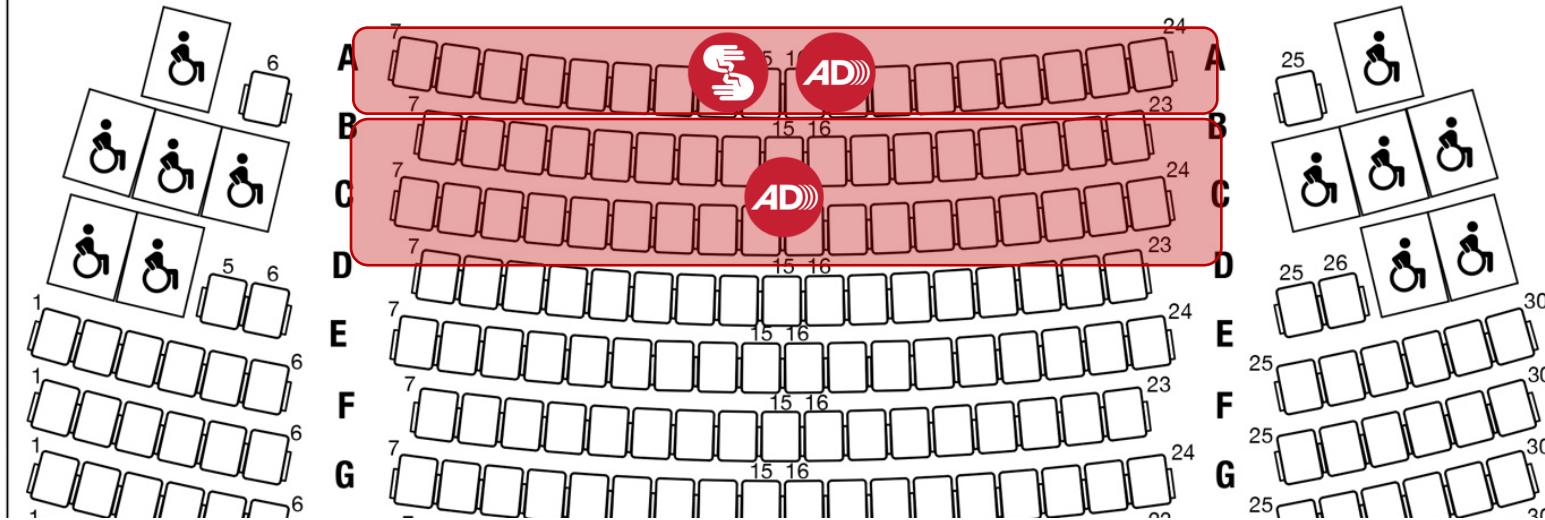
